#### GUEST SPEAKER

Dr. Wakefield has been awarded Mastership in the Academy of General Dentistry, Fellowship in the American and International Colleges of Dentists and designator "A" status from the United States Surgeon General. He is currently a Consultant to the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association. Dr. Wakefield is a frequently invited national speaker on the subjects of restorative and esthetic materials and techniques.
