Speaker

Donna M. Hecker, D.D.S., M.S., private practice limited to prosthodontics, Eden Prairie, Minnesota. Dr. Hecker began her career in dentistry as a dental laboratory technician. She completed the maxillofacial technician training program at MD Anderson Cancer Center. Later she earned her DDS from the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, Dental School. She then practiced dentistry with the US Public Health Service in Anchorage, Alaska, prior to completing her prosthodontic residency at the Mayo Clinic. Dr. Hecker was employed by Gundersen Lutheran in LaCrosse, Wisconsin from 1995-1998, and served as Director of Maxillofacial Prosthetic Services at the University of Minnesota from 1998-2003. Dr. Hecker now maintains a private practice limited to prosthodontics. She is currently the President of the Minnesota Academy of Restorative Dentistry, serves on the Board of Directors of the American Academy of Maxillofacial Prosthetics (AAMP), and is a Fellow in the AAMP and Academy of Prosthodontics.
