### SPEAKERS

**Paul S. Belvedere**, D.D.S., Adjunct Professor, School of Dentistry, University of Minnesota. Dr. Belvedere is an internationally renowned teacher, author, inventor and innovator in composite dentistry. He maintains a full-time general and cosmetic dental practice in Edina, Minnesota. He has been a featured speaker for the ADA, ASDA, AACD, AGD as well as for several other dental schools worldwide. Dr. Belvedere has written a chapter in Dental Clinics of North America and is a consultant to several dental manufacturers.

**Fred McIntyre**, D.D.S., M.S., Clinical Associate Professor of Restorative Dentistry at SUNY Buffalo; Diplomate, American Board of Prosthodontics. Dr. McIntyre is also Director of the Esthetic Dentistry Education Center: Director of Prosthodontics and *Clinical Coordinator of Continuing Education Programs in Esthetic Dentistry*. Dr. McIntyre has been active in research and has received five research grants. He has published several articles in refereed publications related to esthetics and has lectures on the subject of esthetics at all levels of dental education. In addition, he has presented invited lectures at local, national; and international meetings. He is a consultant for Ivoclar North America Inc., Medical Quality Foundation, Intra Corp, Accumed and PVS Jelenko. Dr. McIntyre maintains a private practice within the University of Dental Associates at SUNY Buffalo.

**K. William Mopper**, D.D.S., M.S. is a leading expert on cosmetic bonding. He is a frequent speaker for several prestigious national meetings, including the Greater New York Dental Meeting, the Chicago Midwinter Meeting, the California Dental Society Meeting and the Hinman Dental Meeting. In addition, he is a continuing education faculty member for the Postgraduate Program in Esthetic Dentistry at SUNY Buffalo as well as at other dental schools. Dr. Mopper is co—author of “A Complete Guide to Dental Bonding” and co—author of a chapter “Coloring with Resins,” in Esthetic Composite Bonding, a text by Ronald E. Jordan. He has written articles for many professional publications, has been a consultant to major facets of the dental industry and is the Co—Founder and Chairman of Cosmedent, Inc.

**Paul Olin, D.D.S., M.S.,** Associate Dean, Clinical Systems; Director, Dental Implant Program; Associate Professor, Division of Prosthodontics, Department of Restorative Sciences, University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry. In addition to his administrative and teaching responsibilities, Dr. Olin practices part—time in the faculty practice at the School of Dentistry. He has extensive clinical and teaching experience with porcelain veneers and with other areas of esthetic dentistry. *Dr. Olin is the Director of the Postgraduate Programs in Esthetic Dentistry: Levels -III at the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry.*

**Edward J. Swift, Jr., D.M.D., M.S,** Professor and Chair, Department of Operative Dentistry, University of North Carolina, School of Dentistry at Chapel Hill. Dr. Swift is actively involved in dental materials research, particularly in the areas of dentin bonding and other aspects of adhesive and esthetic dentistry. He has published over 170 journal articles and has written eight textbook chapters. Dr. Swift is a member of the editorial boards of *Practical Periodontics and Aesthetic Dentistry, Operative Dentistry, Journal of Dentistry,* and *American Journal of Dentistry* and is the Associate Editor for the *Journal of Esthetic Dentistry.* He maintains a part—time intramural practice devoted to restorative and esthetic dentistry.
