## SPEAKERS

**Kenneth Koch**, D.M.D., Founder and past Director of the new program in Postdoctoral Endodontics at the Harvard School of Dental Medicine. Prior to his endodontic career, Dr. Koch spent ten years in the Air Force and held the position of Chief of Prosthodontics at Osan AFB and at Mcguire AFB. Dr. Koch is the author of numerous articles in endodontics and has lectured extensively both in the United States and abroad. He maintains a faculty position at Harvard and is active in private practice, limited to endodontics. Dr. Koch is Co-founder of Real World Endo™, an endodontic education company providing clinically oriented courses in endodontics.

**Alan Law**, D.D.S., Ph.D. (Neuroscience), Clinical Associate Professor, Division of Endodontics, Department of Restorative Sciences, University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry. Dr. Law is a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics; President of the Minnesota Association of Endodontists; and also maintains a full-time private practice limited to Endodontics.

**Paul Olin**, D.D.S., M.S., Associate Dean, Clinical Systems; Director, Dental Implant Program; Associate Professor, Division of Prosthodontics, Department of Restorative Sciences, University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry. In addition to his administrative and teaching responsibilities, Dr. Olin practices part-time in the faculty practice at the School of Dentistry. *Dr. Olin is the Director of the Postgraduate Programs in Esthetic Dentistry: Levels I-III at the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry.*
