GUEST SPEAKER

John A. Molinari, Ph.D., Professor and Chairman, Department of Biomedical Sciences, University of Detroit Mercy School of Dentistry. Dr. Molinari has published over 300 scientific articles, text chapters and abstracts in the areas of Microbiology and Immunology, is a co-author of the text Practical Infection Control in Dentistry, and has lectured nationally and internationally on topics dealing with infectious diseases and dental asepsis. He also serves as a consultant for hospitals in the Detroit area and serves as a consultant to the ADA. Previously, he was the Project Coordinator for the governmental Health Resources and Services Administration Task Force on AIDS and Dental Education, and Chairman of the American Association of Dental Schools Curriculum Advisory Committee on Bloodborne Infectious Diseases. Dr. Molinari is also a consultant to the CDC in the areas of infectious disease and infection control. He is Past Chairman of OSAP and a present board member of the OSAP Foundation. Currently, he is the Infection Control Section editor for *The Compendium of Continuing Education in Dentistry*, and has been a member of the Editorial Board for the *Journal of the American Dental Association*. In recognition of his efforts, Dr. Molinari has been inducted as an honorary member of the Michigan Dental Association, the International College of Dentists, the American College of Dentists, and served as Chairman of the State of Michigan Governor's Risk Reduction and AIDS Policy Commission.
