## SPEAKERS

**Alan Law**, D.D.S., Ph.D. (Neuroscience), Clinical Associate Professor, Division of Endodontics, Department of Restorative Sciences, University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry. Dr. Law is a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics; President of the Minnesota Association of Endodontists; and also maintains a full-time private practice limited to Endodontics.

**Dan Nathanson**, D.M.D., M.S. D., Professor and Chair, Restorative Sciences and Biomaterials, Boston University, Goldman School of Graduate Dentistry.
